Solution: The process includes scoping the item, sketching, prototyping with cardboard, selecting materials and tools like tin snips, hammer, and rivets, preparing and marking the metal, cutting, joining, and finishing by smoothing edges and applying colors. Quality must include proper measurement, smooth surfaces, and robust joints. Safety includes using goggles and gloves.
