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1. Light creates visibility; define it.

Light allows us to see objects by reflecting off them. Without it, objects are invisible.

2. Black box design in theatres.

Starting with dark spaces minimizes unwanted reflections, enhancing lighting control.

3. Purpose of stage lighting.

Initially for visibility, it evolved to convey moods, settings, and textures in storytelling.

4. Lighting as storytelling.

Lighting designs create emotional atmospheres, helping audiences engage with performances.

5. Floodlights: simple lighting fixtures.

Floodlights cover large areas but lack beam control, producing significant heat in tungsten versions.

6. PAR lamps for intense illumination.

PARs generate bright, oval beams but have a fixed shape. They're ideal for general stage coverage.



7. Fresnel lights and their control.

Fresnel lights have adjustable beams and are recognized by concentric lens rings for varied use.

8. Using barndoors with PCs.

Plano-Convex (PC) lights have defined edges and can be shaped to control light spillage effectively.

9. Spotlights focus on details.

They illuminate specific areas with precision, enhancing the performance's focal points.

10. Gobos add texture.

Gobos allow designers to project patterns, giving light beams a textured, dynamic look.

11. Sound design: enhancing theatre.

Incorporates music and effects to support narratives without overshadowing dialogue.

12. Three main categories in sound systems.

Categories include input, signal routing, and output, ensuring clear sound delivery.



13. Importance of acoustics.

Good auditorium acoustics reduce the need for microphones, enhancing actor clarity.
